GUIDELINES

- Senior students coming from various/diverse bachelor backgrounds endorsed by their respective University
- The confirmed participants will be joining a 1-day mentoring session in preparation for their 5-minute pitch.
- Categories will be created and students will be grouped according to the backgrounds of the participants.
- During the pitching event, the participants will be given 5 minutes using only 5 slides to pitch their research idea and an additional 2 minutes for a Q & A afterwards.

• Presentation should include Introduction, Main Idea and Conclusion.

 Pitch exceeding the time will be disqualified.

• Awards will be given.


